



## **KMG Global for Specialist Crew**

Established KMG is starting an international directory for specialist crews working across natural history filmmaking. This will be used to assist production companies around the world looking for specialist skill sets, and crews based in or already working on location. This match-making service supports production to work more sustainably, and quickly find specialist skills and knowledge around the world. KMG is looking to work with filmmaking crews such as camera operators, assistants, sound, etc, but also safety and support topside and underwater.

### **How it works**

The KMG Global Crew directory will hold detailed profiles with all the information about the crew member including location, skills and experience. All members will be vetted with references, and up to date CV and showreel if relevant.

When looking for crew, productions will contact KMG via email ([Katie@kmgmanagement.co.uk](mailto:Katie@kmgmanagement.co.uk)) with details of what they are looking for. All information about the shoot will be kept confidential between KMG and the production company, and NDA's can be signed where requested.

Where suitable crew are found, KMG will pass on their details for the production company to then get directly in contact, and KMG is no longer involved. If suitable crew are not found, KMG can set alerts for 'required crew'. When new or existing crew update their profiles to match the 'requested crew' criteria, a notification will be sent to the production. All crew suggestions will be fully vetted by KMG and references / testimonials can also be sent to production.

An exciting feature KMG Global is proud to announce is potential shoot sharing of crew members. Should the location, skill set and dates work, KMG will work with the production companies to share the talent (maintaining confidentiality at all times), thereby reducing travel and environmental costs.

### **Key Features of KMG Global Crew**

The directory is a custom designed platform and subscribed crew will have a log in where they complete a profile, inputting information on their qualifications, skills, experience, kit, showreels, references, location, etc. This can be updated by crew at any time. The key features of this system are the detailed skill criteria for specialist skills i.e. underwater, rope access, drone, etc, the requirement for references from recent work, and a calendar where crews can update the locations of their work bookings – this enables shoot shares to be explored. This platform will be carefully managed and updated, working closely with production to find the talent they are looking for.

### **Fees**

There are no fees! This is a completely free service for production to use, as crew members pay a subscription fee to be part of the directory.
